Competition Play Procedure Effective March 2021

Overview

This Procedure outlines the practices adopted in accordance with Scottish Golf guidelines to support member competition play. These will apply to all club competitions listed on club website for 2021 season, any changes will be advised when known

Please also continue to adhere to the Operating Procedure criteria during competition play

Competition Entry and World Handicap System provides additional detail aligned to Covid - 19 requirements

Competition Play - Applicable to club members

1. The first club competition is from 2nd April with all competitions posted on club website. **These will be handicap counting competitions.** New members wanting to secure a handicap index can contact gmc bain@hotmail.co.uk
2. Cost of entry will be £3:00, optional £2 sweep
3. **Competition entry must be booked via club website, www.alvagolfclub.co.uk in advance of play as this will be used to obtain the list of players entered. No booking no competition entry. Please ensure you have partner(s) to play with and name(s) added to the notes section when booking.**
4. Players finishing first nine holes have right of play before group starting their round
5. Each player is responsible for keeping their own score, verified verbally by their playing partners. No swapping, signing of cards required, ensure legible with name given. Score cards available in locker room. **Putts to be holed out (competition play only)**
6. Score card returns can be entered via locker room terminal or Master Score Board on completion of play. Please adhere to hand sanitisation procedures. Competition winners will be advised in due course
7. Competition entry / score card returns are to be made using Competition Entry / Score Card Returns door slot in locker room

Social Distancing to be exercised at ALL times

Exercise particular caution from car park onto course around clubhouse and 1st tee
