Operating Procedure Effective 10th July 2020

Overview

This Procedure outlines the operational practices adopted in accordance with latest Scottish Golf guidelines. These will remain in place until such guidance has been updated. It is important that members follow the requirements below to ensure as a club we meet the criteria that permits golf to be played and enjoyed on our course going forward

General

Member play adhering to Playing Golf details below

- a) Do Not visit the golf club if you :
 - have been out of the country within the previous 14 days
 - have been instructed to self isolate
 - are displaying Covid 19 symptoms
- b) The clubhouse / toilets are planned to reopen on applicable Government advice
- c) Club competition golf, as per new revised fixture list posted on website, will start on the 10th July onwards

Playing Golf

Applicable to club members

It is a requirement for members to **book a tee time in advance of play (for general and competition play)** to meet Track and Trace criteria in the event of a Covid 19 incident related to golf course. Tee times, for 1 to 4 players, can be booked via club website. www.alvagolfclub.co.uk The individual making a tee time booking can add the names of other players playing in the group (if applicable), whilst adhering to point b) below.

- a) The course will be open for play from 7:00am daily
- b) Play is permitted for upto 4 players per group, comprising of players from no more than three separate households
- c) Players arriving for play at 1st tee must be ready for tee off - locker room access is available
- d) Tee off for 1st hole only when group in front has teed off for 2nd Hole, maintaining one playing group per hole
- e) Bunkers are now in play, play ball as it lies and repair sand as best with feet on leaving
- f) No golfer to touch / remove flag / flagstick, no requirement to hole out on green (general play only)
- g) All players requested to leave course / car park following completion of play, clubhouse will be open only during bar hours
- h) In the event of a Track and Trace requirement member contact details would be provided to the local authority respecting confidentiality
- i) Players to be mindful of the general public if on the course
- j) Please take all your personal items and waste with you when leaving the course
- k) Members are advised to refer to Scottish Golf website for further Covid 19 guidance
